For the first time in Tajikistan, a special 6-day training course will be held for lead auditors on ISO 9000 from May 13 till May 19. This event will be conducted by the International Trade Centre (ITC) under the Trade Promotion Program in Tajikistan financed by the Government of Switzerland.

The training gives an opportunity for the representatives from the fruit and vegetable processing enterprises, relevant governmental structures, and business support services organizations to learn about principles of implementing and realization of Quality Management System according to ISO 9001 standard, and also to explain the audit process covering audit planning, conduct, reporting and follow up activities in accordance with ISO 9001. The ISO 9000 quality management system is generic in nature and applicable to all companies, regardless of the type and size of the business, including small and medium enterprises (SMEs), and they are applicable to all categories of goods and services.

According to Saidmumin Kamolov, National Manager of ITC "Trade Promotion Program in Tajikistan", implementation of the ISO 9001:2000 standard will allow a company to improve the effectiveness of the quality management system in meeting customer requirements.

The participants successfully taken a written exam, get the certificate issued by British company "*Nigel Bauer and Associates*" and are valid for three years.
